Per our conversation on Thursday, March 18, I have been directed by Governor Schwarzenegger to take a comprehensive view of both the guidelines and the specific contract that was competitively awarded by the California Energy Commission to Portland Energy Incorporated, a solicitation referred as Program Opportunity Notice PON 400-09-402 Municipal and Commercial Building Targeted Measure Retrofit Program.

We believe, given the Department of General Services' expertise in both contract review and guidelines of competitively awarded contracts, the department is best suited to perform this objective review.

These funds in question are part of what California has received through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act for the State Energy Program. We request that you deploy department resources as soon as possible given the requirement for timely distribution of funds and offer an objective analysis on whether both the competitive guidelines and application submitted by Portland Energy Inc. were awarded appropriately. Your analysis should address, at a minimum, the question of whether any conflict of interest laws, principles or policies were violated in this process.
