Job Tracking

- Energy Commission developed a database to track job creation and other program metrics
- Energy Commission provides initial and ongoing training to funding recipients to assist with reporting requirements and help ensure data integrity
- Energy Commission is executing two contracts to assist in the monitoring, evaluation, verification and auditing of ARRA expenditures, job creation and other program metrics

JOBS

Job Creation

- Significant job creation expected summer/fall 2010
- Based on DOE estimates, over 3,000 jobs for the SEP and Block Grant programs
- Leveraged job creation expected to be 3 or 4 times the ARRA funded jobs created.
